In accordance with section 109 of the Gambling Act 2003, the Net Proceeds Committee of the New Zealand Racing Board has conducted a review of the criteria, methods, systems and policies used for consideration of applications for the distribution of net proceeds. All applications are considered against our Authorised Purposes for racing and amateur sports and eligibility criteria. For amateur sports, registration with the New Zealand Charities Commission or being an Incorporated Society is a minimum requirement.

Declined Applications

We urge applicants to carefully read the guidelines on the Grant Application Form to ensure funding criteria is met and all relevant information supplied.
